

GUIDELINES FOR THE LARSEN COOPERATIVE COMPANY HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Larsen Cooperative will be offering graduating seniors a chance to apply for thirty **\$500 scholarships**. In order to qualify for these scholarships the graduating high school senior must meet the following criteria.

- 1) The parents, parent, or guardian of the graduating senior must be a member of Larsen Cooperative and have purchased at least \$1,000 worth of goods and services from Larsen Cooperative from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.
- 2) The individual must be going on to attend a technical school, a two-year school, or a four-year college.
- 3) The individual will be required to complete a scholarship questionnaire provided by Larsen Cooperative and if requested by Larsen Cooperative an interview. This information will be evaluated by a scholarship committee chosen by the cooperative. The committee will consist of employees, board members and patrons of Larsen Cooperative.
- 4) If chosen as a scholarship winner, the individual will need to complete his/her freshman year of college or first year of technical school and provide the cooperative with proof that they compiled at least a "C" average in their course work. The scholarship must be used toward expenses incurred during his/her second year of post high school education.
